Q: As a Paranormal Investigator, do you believe in mediums?

A: With over 40 years in the paranormal field, working on Haunted Australia, Chronicles X, and with Australian Ghost Adventures, I've used all sorts of gear trying to prove the paranormal exists.

Here's my truth though: equipment can't always be trusted. It's helpful, sure. However for me, a good

medium is the sharpest tool in the kit when walking into a potentially haunted site.

Let the medium go in first. Let them feel the space, pinpoint the hotspots. That gives you a map, a real edge, for setting up your tech: cameras, recorders, whatever you've got.

Then, if something hits, you can cross-check it with the medium's impressions. If they line up? Now you've got something worth digging into.

T was broad daylight; bright, clear and deceptively normal. Just another house call... or so I thought. A young couple had contacted me, concerned about strange activity in their home.

I told him, "They're here, but they can't move on because you keep calling them back. You have to let them go."


We did the work with the help of my guides; gently helping his friends to move on to their next evolution and closing down the residual doorways. I could feel the air lighten a little.

Then we headed into the bedroom. And that's where things got nasty.

The energy was dark and heavy, as if something was crouching just out of sight. As I tuned in, I caught sight of a male spirit. Wiry frame, greasy hair, hollow eyes and a deeply invasive energy.


"There's a man here," I said. "Skinny, long-haired. He's been interfering with your possessions."
