Ask An Expert



Q: As a Paranormal Investigator, what tools do you use?

E asked Soula Raven Vaitsis from Paranormal Adventures

Australia for her thoughts on the question. Each issue we'll pose your questions to our experienced panel.

A: I particularly like working with dowsing rods, not in the traditional way that most in the paranormal field use them.

I experiment by putting them upright in a frame or holder that can allow them to operate without them being in your hands. That way there are no other influences, such as our own

energy or thoughts, to move them. Then, when they move, I know they are responding intelligently and that I definitely have made contact and am interacting with a spirit entity.

The REM (Radiating Electro-Magneticity) pod is another piece of equipment I choose to use. This has the ability to detect disturbances in its own electromagnetic field including temperature changes. Some think it works similarly to a K2 meter or a cat ball, both of which can detect motion. To a degree it does, yet its

sensitivity is stronger and, in my experience, easier for spirits to manipulate.

Of course, I always have a voice recorder going. You just never know what you may capture that is beyond physical hearing.

THE GIFT OF A KISS

There are moments in life when the veil between this world and the next feels impossibly thin. A song plays at just the right time, a feather drifts across your path, a fragrance fills the air with no earthly source and, in that instant, you know you are not alone. Yet so often, people dismiss these subtle visitations as mere coincidence. Others refute them altogether, insisting that there is nothing beyond that which we can measure and explain.

OWEVER, based on the events of my life, I cannot agree. Evidence has been scattered or I should say, woven through, with experiences too precise, too tender, too unmistakably timed to ignore. From a young child I had the memory of another family, an Indian mum and dad with three children. Now, we are talking about England in the 1940's remember, so very few people of unfamiliar cultures had arrived on our shores and none in the country towns and villages around my birthplace. I waited for a long time believing this family would come and find me, yet I had to wait until I was 45 for that story to play out.

My mother was totally against any sort of spirit talk, including religion and I could not understand why. I could see people around her, especially a gentle looking man. Years later, when I finally saw a picture of her birth father, I realised with a shock that he was the same man I had seen by her side. Eventually, I learned that my grandmother had attended séances and taken my mother along as a child. No wonder she turned her back on it all; she had been taught to fear.

Over the ensuing years, in my need to make sense of 'knowing' and 'seeing' what others couldn't, I explored everything from various

faith, Ouija boards, tarot cards and discussions with anyone I came across that felt as I did. It led me into so many adventures as I discovered that Spirit has a way of reaching through, without fanfare and drama, simply with gentle nudges of reassurance. A dream that carries a message. A sudden memory sparked just when you need encouragement. A sign that answers the question you hadn't dared to speak aloud. These are not random happenings. To me, they are proof that those who love us never really leave.

I want to reassure you that, should you have ever wondered whether there is more to life than what we perceive, there is. You are not imagining it.

So, here we are, my story, which is engraved in my mind and heart forever.

My daughter was diagnosed with breast cancer, an enormous shock, as it was a condition that had never appeared in our family. After much discussion with doctors, she chose her own treatment path, asking questions and making decisions with clarity and courage. As a natural health practitioner, I supported her choices while beginning our own complementary approach.
