Ghost Talk: Experienced Opinions

Tasmania has a raft of haunted locations that surpass the mainland sites, due to its rich and colourful history. Sadly, a lot of that history is sinister and gruesome. We asked Sharmaine Mansfield, owner-operator of Tasmania's Most Haunted, the following question.

Q: What would be the most haunted place in Tasmania and why?

A: Willow Court is widely considered one of the most haunted places in Tasmania and for good reason. Our team has been hosting paranormal investigations at the site for over 13 years and, in that time; we have experienced activity unlike anywhere else we have worked.

Willow Court operated for nearly two centuries as an asylum, housing thousands of patients, staff and families. The emotional weight,

lived experiences and layered history of the site are immense. Over the years, we have recorded intelligent responses, unexplained sounds, environmental changes and interactions that consistently occur across different areas of the precinct.

What makes Willow Court stand out is the consistency of experiences reported by investigators, guests and our staff. Even by people with

no prior knowledge of the site. Combined with its long, complex history, Willow Court remains a place where the past feels very close to the present.

It's been 22 years since paranormal experiences exhilarated the emotions and feelings within me and, I can honestly say, I thought I would never feel it again. For the past four years I have felt a stir within myself, a spiritual stir that I have been learning from and trying to understand. However, it wasn't until I visited the old St Arnaud Convent in Victoria by chance about a year ago, that things started to connect with my spiritual growth.

THAT first step into the entrance was the beginning of my communication with the spirits that still reside there. I felt like I was home. Like I belonged.

A very strange feeling, as why on earth would a convent feel like home to me? I am a person who believes in our Lord Jesus Christ, so the stories of the hauntings did not scare me. I wanted to connect the spiritual part of this beautiful, big old convent. As time went on events started to unfold and eventually become very clear.

The chapel at the convent is still consecrated, however, at night it felt very unsettling and creepy. You see, *Paranormal Adventures Australia* (PAA) was planning a Halloween Paranormal sleepover at the Convent and later we were to run public paranormal tours. So, I spent a lot of time at the Convent, sometimes just me and my Bull Arab dog, Ivy.

Most of the investigators in the team had connections to similar places. Kerry, lived in the twin convent called St. Xavier's, like the school at St. Arnaud Convent with an identical layout. Her mother cared for children. David's father lived in an orphanage from birth to 18 years old and Janet, who is an embalmer and mortician, regularly deals with death, churches and chapels. Jodie is the caretaker and Kristy, whom at times assists Jodie and lastly me. I suffered spiritual oppression 25 years ago and was assisted by religious clergy. After that I moved towards helping people and investigating.

Unfortunately, many have stayed at the Convent and previous tour companies have not treated the place with respect. I knew there would be activity and that we had some spiritual cleaning up to do.

The team investigated the Convent over a two day period and, while it began quietly, it did not end that way.

We heard the sound of children's feet running in the hallway upstairs, things being dragged, heavy boots, giggles and unexplainable chills. As we got deeper into the investigation the communication ramped up.

On the second night I cleansed the whole Convent. The team stayed together through this process and, when we were in the dormitory, standing close together, we all heard a huge snarly growl. We all froze. “Did you hear that?” It felt like it was right behind me and in my ear. Not much frightens me yet this did. It scared all of us. We knew we had to get out of the dormitory and we did. For the first time in 20 years I wanted to leave a location. However, we persevered and stayed though.

We all moved downstairs into one room together. The next morning, as David was having breakfast in the big old kitchen, he heard someone walking towards the kitchen. It stopped at the entrance of the door. He looked and no one was there.

Jodie and Kristy heard children, muffled music and giggling when caretaking. All three of us have seen what we believe to be the “White Nun”, in various areas but mainly at the window where we sleep.

One particular morning I was woken up at approximately 7am by the sound of someone walking and banging around in the kitchen.

It was a Sunday morning so would have been church day for the Convent and the children. My dog did not move, just looked up towards the kitchen. I thought it was Jodie and said, “Jodie is that you? Good morning?”

I heard aloud clear female voice say “Good Morning” and rolled back to sleep. I then woke up a couple of hours later, went to the kitchen and called out for Jodie. She was not in the kitchen, not anywhere in the building; her car was not in the driveway. So I messaged her to ask where she was. She had just woken up! Holy crap! So, who said “Good morning” to me in that loud voice?

On a separate occasion, I spent four nights at the Convent. Three nights I was alone with my dog and the spirits, there to prepare for the Halloween event. I felt very uneasy and, for some reason, I was concerned something would happen. I had a feeling of dread and didn't know why.

The first night I barely slept. I could hear walking as though from upstairs. The room I was in was not part of the 2nd floor and I believe the sound was coming from the infirmary upstairs. My dog barked and growled at the door of the room a few times so I barricaded the door and that was it.

On the second night, I could hear chattering outside the door. The kitchen is outside that door. The third night I felt that someone or something was in the room with me. I didn't feel uneasy. The fourth night Jodie stayed with me and I believe this was the morning we both felt someone touching our toes and backs to wake us up. A nun?

The last time I was there, to cut this long and private experience short, I got quite the fright. At one point in the night, there is about an hour that I cannot remember. Three of my team members were there and recorded the second part of it and I was shocked. I didn’t believe them at first. It was not me and far from who I was or the rules I strictly follow in investigations and Christ.

When we went to bed Jodie witnessed us all sleeping, facing the same direction. I felt unusually light and okay. I had an unstoppable urge to go into the chapel on my own and cleanse. In the chapel, I covered my head with a lace shawl, lit a white candle, burnt frankincense and Myrrh resin in front of the altar and played deliverance prayers loudly. I cried and I had no idea why.

Then I felt a soft hand rest on my right shoulder. I knew it was one of the sisters and whatever I did was forgiven. I walked out of the chapel feeling lighter like I was floating, at peace and closer to our creator.

The Convents spirits have shown the team and me so much and reminded us of what we may have forgotten. This was why it felt like home.

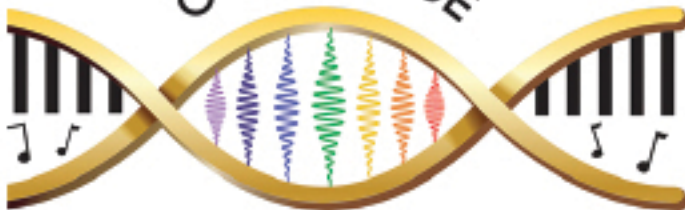
